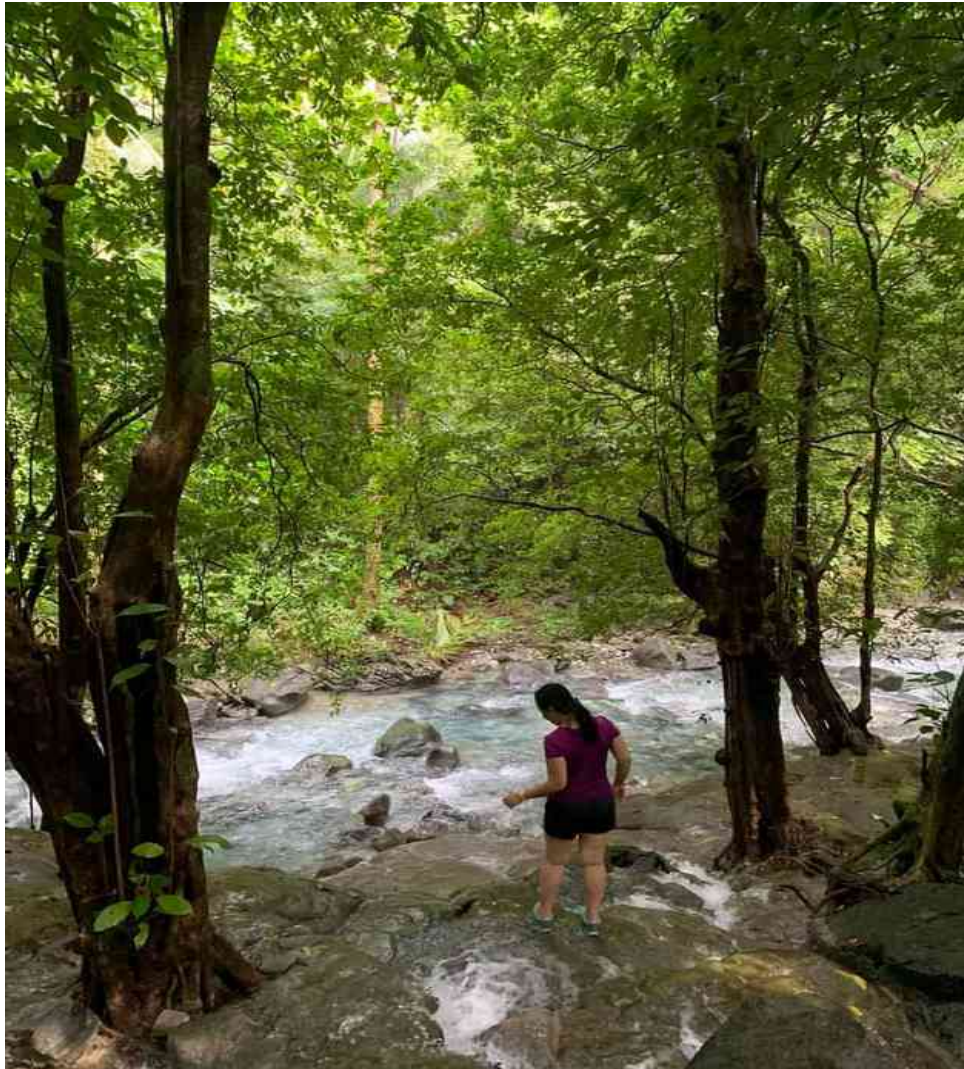




ACCOMPLISHMENT REPORT
